## PART ONE: Create a slide and name it 'MY COUNTRY'

Photo 1 > Find a map of your country.

- Introduce your country: name, capital, number of inhabitants, number of regions, main cities.



Photo 2 > Find a picture of the flag of your country.

- Describe the flag of your country: colours, symbols
- Do not forget to say what the colours and/or symbols stand for (= represent).



Photos 3 & 4 > Find 2 photos illustrating 2 important moments in the history of your country.

- Describe when these two events / moments happened and what happened.



Photos 5 & 6 > Find 2 photos representing 2 important monuments / places people can visit in the capital city of YOUR country.

- Describe these monuments (What are they famous for? When were they built? Who built them?, What do they commemorate?, etc.)



**Photos 7 & 8** > Find 2 photos representing 2 important monuments / places people can visit in two other cities in YOUR country.

- Describe these monuments (What are they famous for? When were they built? Who built them?, What do they commemorate?, etc.).

**Photos 9 & 10** > Find 2 photos representing 2 important people in the history of YOUR country.

- Describe when these two people lived and what they did for your country.

**Photo 11** > Find a photo representing an important festival or national celebration in YOUR country.

- Describe when this festival or national celebration takes place, how long it has existed, and what people do.
